CORAM: HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE NAJMI WAZIRI ORDER

The hearing has been conducted through hybrid mode (physical and virtual hearing).

- 1. Under various directions of this court, for nearly half a decade the Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD has planted lakhs of trees in hundreds of acres of forest lands in the Central and Southern Ridge and nurtured them as *Insaaf Bagh* (Justice Park) and *Muafi Bagh* (Atonement Park) respectively. The orders for plantation of trees extended to other parts of the city as well. At the time of plantation, it was to be ensured by the Deputy Conservator of Forests ('DCF') that the trees had a minimum nursery-age of three years and a height of not less than 6ft.
- 2. The learned ASC, GNCTD submits that 35,000 more trees have been planted in *Muafi Bagh* in compliance of the order dated 30.08.2022. In effect the total number of trees planted in *Muafi Bagh* is in the range of 2,55,000 and approximately 67,000 trees have been planted as *Insaaf Bagh*. Another 14,000 trees have been planted under court orders by DDA in the Central Ridge and along the Yamuna river belt. Quite a few of the trees are about almost eight years old now and some have attained a height of over 35 feet.
- 3. Let the Department of Forests file an affidavit demarcating on a map the area, along with geo coordinates, in which *Insaaf Bagh* and *Muafi Bagh* have been nurtured. The affidavit shall also indicate the equivalent compensatory plantations carried out by the GNCTD in





terms of its assurance to this court on earlier dates. Six monthly reports shall be filed in this regard along with photographs and satellite images/drone photographs to show the progress of growth in the said two large areas and other areas in which further plantation is being carried out.

4. It is a matter of record that the lakhs of trees planted by the Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD, were procured from the millions of rupees deposited as costs, in scores of cases before this court. The resultant rejuvenation of the otherwise barren areas of the city, be it the Ridge or the city's arterial roads, or some District Parks, neighbourhood/ colony parks, is because of the collective efforts of Department Forests (GNCTD), the learned Court Commissioners, government counsel, lawyers and litigants. There has been active community participation. This needs to be acknowledged and encouraged. Community participation inculcates a sense of duty to protect one's environment and an immediate affinity to one's neighbourhood and the city. It would therefore be appropriate that there be signages and street directions to guide both, the curious and the enthusiast, to these green areas in particular to *Insaaf Bagh* and to Muafi Bagh. It would be expected of the PWD and MCD and other road-owning agencies to install appropriate road/street signages at multiple places. The signages shall be put up at places which may be identified by the learned Court Commissioners. The DCF (HQ) is made the Nodal Officer in this regard for coordination with the roadowning agencies such as the PWD, MCD, NDMC and DDA. Compliance affidavit be filed.
